Its intrinsic value is evident in terms of well-crafted period features including teak joinery, fire places and surrounds, leaded glass, well-proportioned colonnade and central court with coffered skylight. The core of building is a good example of an elaborated bungalow typology. While the building is screened from the Main Road by existing vegetation, the building occupies a landmark location at the 'knuckle' of the Main Road alignment.
- The Committee supports the recommendation of the Overstrand Heritage Committee that the building would benefit from adaptive reuse.

The Committee recommends that the expanded heritage statement include the input of a heritage consultant with architectural and urban design expertise. Revised proposals must be submitted to local conservation bodies for comment.
