The Committee recommends that the stop works order be withdrawn by HWC and that the construction of the remainder of the pipeline be condoned. This is subject to the implementation of clauses 1, 2.1 and 2.2 proposed in the letter from Mr Hangone written on behalf of the church, dated 20 March 2013.

- There is no proposal that triggers S38.
- Three separate S34 applications must be submitted.

The Committee resolved that the buildings are derelict and beyond repair and therefore reluctantly will approve their demolition after following the Memorandum of Agreement process with SAHRA. The case officer is to ensure that the processes and requirements of the MoU are followed.
