The pursuit of renewable energy is evident through the installation of three wind turbines and 220 solar panels.

In a unique twist, guests themselves can contribute to the hotel's sustainable efforts. They can generate power by climbing the stairs or descending via the energy-efficient lift or engage in an energy-producing workout at the hotel's gym, showcasing a holistic approach to sustainability.
