**HESSEQUA MUNISIPALITEIT****REGSTELLING**

Die volgende regstelling word gedoen in die Hessequa Grondgebruikbeplanningverordening, soos gepubliseer in die Provinsie van die Wes-Kaap: *Buitengewone Provinsiale Koerant*, 7472, op 21 Augustus 2015:

“**Municipality**” means the municipality of Hessequa established by Establishment Notice P.N. 21/2006 in Provincial Gazette 6335 of 3 January 2006, issued in terms of the Local Government: Municipal Structures Act, 1998 (Act 117 of 1998), and where the context so requires, includes—

- (a) the Council;
- (b) another political structure or a political office bearer of the Municipality, authorised or delegated to perform a function or exercise a power in terms of this By-Law;
- (c) the Tribunal authorised or delegated to perform a function or exercise a power in terms of this By-Law;
- (d) the Municipal Manager; and
- (e) an authorised employee.
