Condition of Contract

BID PART 2 – SECTION 3 – SUB-SECTION 3.5.6 (ACCESS TO SITE) – PUBLIC LIABILITY OF R10 MILLION TO BE ADDED TO THE BIDDING DOCUMENT AS A CONDITION OF CONTRACT (Page 32)

It will be a requirement as set out in the bidding document that the contractor will have to submit proof of minimum insurance covers pertaining in this contract, in no later than 10 working days upon receiving a Letter of Intent of Award of this contract from the Employer. Failure to do so will result in the tender being non-responsive.

Note that only fully completed documents from an Accredited Insurer will be accepted. No third-party documentation will be accepted. The minimum Public Liability cover of **R10 000 000 (ten million rand)** must be clearly stated on the insurance document.



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- 3.5.3. The Contractor shall have access to an electricity connection and supply at the existing system and the right to use such electricity at the site as required during the performance of its obligations noted hereunder and for purposes of operating the system, which cost of electricity is for the Department's account; and
- 3.5.4. The Contractor shall have the right to construct storage space at the existing system convenient to the location of the system, for Equipment, Plant and Materials used during the performance of its obligations noted hereunder.
- 3.5.5. Site hand over will be granted at the discretion of the Department and not necessarily be aligned with the award of this contract.
- 3.5.6. It will be a requirement that the contractor will have to submit proof of a valid minimum Public Liability cover of R10 000 000 (ten million rand) and must be clearly stated on the insurance document, in no later than 10 working days upon receiving a Letter of Intent of Award of this contract from the Employer. Failure to do so will result in the tender being non-responsive.

Note that only fully completed documents from an Accredited Insurer will be accepted. No third-party documentation will be accepted.
