




CTIA Departure Drop Off Area








Road Upgrades: Hospital Bend Pre Selection Scheme












AIRPORT CITY LINK: BMT LANE




Airport City Link: BMT Lane: Inbound

Koeberg Interchange Upgrade Phase 1 (2010)





- Cape Town has <u>16 000</u> rooms within <u>45 minute driving radius</u> of City centre
- 7000 rooms within 15 minute driving radius of stadium
- 3500 of these rooms are within 15 minute walking distance














Philippi Stadium: Proposed Venue Specific Training Site for Cape Town






